STRUCTURE OF RESPONSIBILITIES

With reference to the activities carried out on the premises of SUPSI DFA/ASP, it is hereby certified that the MoMe Labs staff are responsible for the participants¹ only and exclusively for the duration of the scheduled activity.

The parent, or guardian, is responsible for the delivery and the collection of each activity participant.

There is the possibility of a supervised communal lunch break. Each participant is required to make arrangements for this lunch. The lunch break will be held in a suitable area. Upon arrival, the participant is asked to confirm their stay for the communal lunch.

In the case of food allergies/intolerances, the parent, or guardian, shall notify MoMe Labs staff.

MoMe Labs staff do not administer medication; in case of need, the participant's parent or guardian must administer the medicine themselves. Costs arising from any possible participant illness/injury, not due to activity-related events, are the responsibility of the parent or guardian.

In the event of damage to the equipment provided caused by the participant, the parent or guardian will be called upon to pay compensation; therefore, personal liability insurance is desirable. The DFA/ASP, through its own liability insurance coverage, assumes liability in the event of damage to the participant's health or property should the full responsibility of the institution be established.

Any dispute arising from the agreement confirmed by this declaration will be subject to Swiss law. Any dispute that cannot be resolved by peaceful agreement between the parties shall be submitted to the jurisdiction of the Lugano Magistrate's Court.
